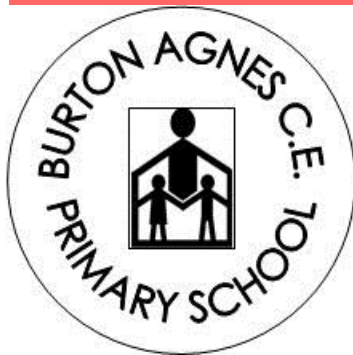

Spelling at Burton Agnes

Last year at Burton Agnes we had a big focus on the way in which we teach spellings in school, trying lots of approaches to help children learn and recall their spellings. We saw a big improvement in the children's weekly test scores but more importantly how they were then able to transfer these spelling skills in to their written work.



At Burton Agnes, we recognise the importance of spelling in supporting a child's ability to communicate effectively and efficiently when writing. By valuing and supporting their efforts to learn spellings each week, you are helping your child to recognise the importance of accurate spelling. As well as learning the words provided, you could help them to identify other words with similar sounds or spelling patterns or rules to deepen their understanding of spelling. There is an emphasis on children becoming competent in spelling in the English National Curriculum and there are clear expectations of the types of words and lists of words they should be able to spell in each year group. The weekly spelling words we provide are in line with these national expectations. Children are proud when they achieve highly in their weekly spelling test and recognise the results of their efforts.

Thank you for your continued support in helping children to learn their weekly spellings.
