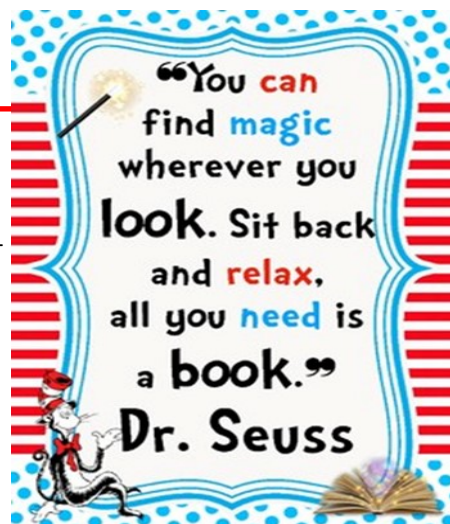
A note from Mrs Jameson

It helps them develop language and listening skills and prepares them to understand the written word. Even after children learn to read themselves, it's still important for you to read aloud together. If you do read with your child please take the time to fill in their reading diary and as the children move in to KS2 feel free to allow the children to record a comment in their diary too.
