At Burton Agnes we are very proud of the time we spend on developing your child's music ability and understanding. From Class 2 up to Class 4 the children take part in music lessons delivered by the music service which we fund from the school budget.

All children develop their skills of percussion playing and in Key stage 2 all children receive 2 years of guitar tuition. The children also experience live music performances from the music service each year.

Singing is also good in school and currently the children are busy learning songs to sing at the Little and Big Sing at Brid Spa. The children in Class 1 will be singing on Monday 9th July from 1.30-2.30 and the children in Classes 3 and 4 will be singing on Wednesday 11th July from 10.15 to 11.45 am.
